



This document explains how to set-up a Playtomic game (applicable to Padel only) at the WPC. For those unfamiliar with Playtomic there is a brief FAQ at the bottom of the document.

Setting up a Playtomic match at the WPC

- Book a court at the centre via Acebook – note that Playtomic and Acebook are not integrated and are two separate systems.
- Set-up a 'Community match' on the Playtomic app. Community matches allow you to set-up matches at courts that are not part of Playtomic and still register them in their app. This is described here:

- As the article notes: Keep in mind that the courts are not automatically booked through the app and that this match is entirely organized by you, so it is the responsibility of the organizer to book the court and sort out payment with the other players either directly or through the app.

Note: Please bear in mind that The Welsh Padel Centre is not responsible for any activity in Playtomic app and it is the organiser's responsibility to pay for the WPC court and, where appropriate, collect monies from other players. In this respect, it is worth noting that, in setting up the match in Playtomic, you are available to specify a cost per player. This is for information only and you are unable to collect payment via Playtomic.

Playtomic FAQ

What is Playtomic?

Playtomic is an app/booking system used by many padel clubs worldwide. It has an in-built dynamic ranking system for individual players which is adjusted after every competitive game (games can be friendlies which don't affect rankings).

By increasing their Playtomic ranking players can join higher standard games.

Why does the WPC not use Playtomic?

Playtomic would replace our Acebook booking system and Playtomic is not cost effective for a club of our size.

Can I join Playtomic?

Yes, the app is free to download and join.
