## **Use of Changing Rooms Policy**

## **Use of Changing Rooms & Toilets at The Welsh Padel Centre**

This Policy covers The Welsh Padel Centre's (WPC) Use of Changing Rooms and Toilets policy.

### **Introduction**

Changing rooms and toilets at The WPC are designed for single occupant use.

There are two changing rooms/toilets. One is designated as unisex and accessible, the other as a 'ladies only' changing room/toilet.

Members of staff, coaches and or volunteers will not accompany anyone into a changing room/toilet. When younger children attend an organised club activity, a DBS checked member of staff or volunteer will, if appropriate, wait outside the changing rooms to allow children to call for assistance if required.

If attending another club as part of an organised club activity (such as, as part of a team), where no changing facilities are available children, parents and travelling teams/players will be made aware prior to the game and advised to make alternative arrangements and to take appropriate additional clothing e.g. tracksuits etc.
